Application deadlines	Semester 1 : application due by April 30 <sup>th</sup> Semester 2 : application due by September 30 <sup>th</sup>
Application procedure	After students have been officially nominated by their home institution and ECAM Lyon has been informed accordingly, ECAM Lyon sends a specific application form to the students. It has to be completed and returned with a detailed CV and latest transcript of records.

Formalities depend on the country of origin.</p> <p>Students from European countries will have to bring a valid European insurance card and will need additional coverage including repatriation and civil liability insurance.</p> <p>For non-European students it is compulsory to be affiliated to the French Social Security system for the on-going academic year (registration online, free of charge) and additional coverage including repatriation and civil liability will also be needed.</p> <p>The ECAM Lyon international office help incoming students with all the insurance issues.</p>
