| Health insurance | EU/EEA/CH → Require a valid EHIC and do not need to be affiliated to French Social Security. Non-EU/EEA/CH → If eligible, mandatory registration with French Social Security system (registration online, free of charge) + private health insurance for the first month. Students who are residents of Quebec are not concerned and must bring a SE 401 Q 106 form. | Arrival / Orientation | An ECAM Lyon representative will greet students at their point of arrival (train or coach station). Students arriving at the airport can take a shuttle into Lyon. All students receive an orientation meeting before the beginning of their courses to prepare them for life in Lyon and their studies at ECAM Lyon. All students receive an ECAM Lyon Student Buddy to welcome them to campus life and activities. When possible, Buddies will speak the student's first language. | |
