This program is open to all international undergraduate students in engineering from all partner universities around the world.

It is a collaboration between 4 partner engineering schools in Lyon. Students choose the school and program that corresponds to his/her major back home. Courses are taught in English by French faculty:

- **ECAM Lyon: Energy and Sustainability (see syllabus)**

Or one of the following schools/programs:

- **CPE:** Chemical engineering
- **ISARA:** Agronomy, agroecology and French agriculture
- **ITECH:** Polymer and Material Sciences

Dates:

Thursday June 8th to Wednesday July 12th, 2017

Content:

- ECAM program: 53 hours of engineering courses, labs, group work and one company visit
- 39 hours of French language classes at ISARA; 3 levels: beginner, intermediate, advanced
- Cultural tours and company visits

Accommodation:

- Student residence hall close to ISARA Lyon

Cost: 2,000€ (fees due by April 15th, 2017)
